HIGHLIGHTS OF THE YEAR

The year gets off to a flying start with the "Rennes Impact Challenge". For two days, you will work in teams to suggest ways of making the city of Rennes more sustainable and environmentally friendly.

The first courses are then immediately applied to a virtual business creation project, the "PUM Adventure": a team project that accompanies you throughout the year and allows you to develop your ideas in a real market context.

The first year ends with a two-month work internship with a commercial focus.

As a bonus, students can get involved in the Bureau de Vie Étudiante (Student Life) association and/or take part in the **Challenge Ecricome**, an inter-school sports challenge.


